# **JUVENILE JUSTICE ASSOCIATION OF TEXAS COMMITTEES**

## **LEGISLATIVE**

Monitors Legislation and make recommendations regarding legislative initiatives. Make recommendations to modify or present new legislation affecting Juvenile Justice. Develop plan in conjunction with the Board of Directors and the Association's Legislative Advocate that represents the goals of the Association.

## **MEMBERSHIP SERVICES COMMITTEE**

Promote membership and recruitment of members for the Association. Organizes membership drives and related activities. Present information about the Association statewide at conferences, scheduled trainings and meetings. Represents the Association to promote the advancement of the Association and Juvenile Justice issues.

## **CONFERENCE & PROGRAM COMMITTEE**

Coordinate the training program and workshops sponsored by the Association at conferences. Provide training relevant to the various requirements for training and certification of Juvenile Justice professionals. Identify training topics and speakers.

## **AWARDS & RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE**

Solicits and reviews nominations for Awards presented annually by the Association. Selects nominees and recipients based on established criteria. Presents recommendations to the Board of Directors and promotes the recognition of the awardees at conferences.

## **JUVENILE JUSTICE CODE (new)**

Review legal issues and services affecting Juvenile Justice. Participates and represents issues of training and professional development in each of the respective areas represented by the Association.

## **PUBLICATIONS & RESEARCH**

Present and publish information in a manner that keeps the membership informed on important issues. Obtains information from various committees and the Board of Directors and disseminates the information. May participate in research and studies relevant to juvenile justice. Presents information in a newsletter or on the web site.

## **NOMINATIONS**

Solicit nominations for elected positions on the Board of Directors. Makes available information regarding the candidates. Prepares the slate of officers and oversees the ballots and nominations process until the elections are completed.

## **STANDARDS & TRAINING**

Provide study and input on the standards promulgated by the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission. Assists with the development of the Legislative agenda regarding standards and requirements.

## **ETHICS**

Upon the direction of the Board of Directors, evaluates any alleged violations by any Association member, of the Code of Ethics or conduct detrimental to the interest of the Association
